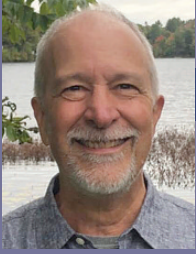

A WORD FROM THE MAYOR

Good weather is upon us and as every spring, due to the thaw, there is degradation and deformation on certain municipal roads. Our public works staff work hard to ensure that our roads are in the best possible condition, despite the difficult and changing weather conditions. I want to share with you our planning for the summer regarding the maintenance of our roads.

This summer, we will work to replenish some of our gravel roads thanks to a grant of nearly \$150,000 received from the Ministère des Transports du Québec (MTQ). The municipality will thus be able to add gravel on Shrewsbury, Sideline, Sheritt, Lac Hughes Ouest and Rodgers roads. As soon as the snow melts, public works staff will be busy picking up abrasive sand on our paved roads, prioritizing intersections, for road safety. During the summer, the yellow lines will be redone.

In June, we will spread the dust suppressant on the gravel roads in order to reduce the dust on our roads. Depending on the summer conditions, we may do a second spreading.

We know Cambria Road needs a lot of work. We are working with the MRC of Argenteuil to present a project to repair this road as part of the MTQ's PIIRL (local road infrastructure intervention plan), this grant program would potentially cover 75% of the cost of the work. We prefer to wait for this grant before starting costly work in order to avoid increasing the tax burden of our residents.

LAKE BARRON

LAKE BARRON BOAT ACCESS

The summer season is fast approaching and it will soon be time to launch your boat for the summer. Access to Lake Barron is controlled by regulation. Annual access is reserved for Lake Barron residents and residents who have notarized access to the lake.

Residents wishing to obtain their annual pass must complete the form to this effect online, in the Environment section of the municipality's website, or go in person to Town Hall to complete it.

All boats must be cleaned before launching. A boat washing station will be available free of charge at the Ecocentre, on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Once the boat has been cleaned, you will have a unique code to access the boat launch by calling the town hall.

Daily access permits are also available for Gore residents and non-residents.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO PLAN IN ADVANCE TO LAUNCH YOUR BOAT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CODE AND WASH YOUR BOAT.

Anyone who operates a motorized boat must have proof of competency indicating that they know the basic rules and know how to operate their boat safely. The most common proof of competency is the Pleasure Craft Operator Card. You can get one by taking a boating safety course in person or online, and passing the exam at the end of the course.

THIS SUMMER, THE SURETÉ DU QUÉBEC WILL PATROL LAKE BARRON AND IF YOU DO NOT HAVE YOUR PERMIT, YOU ARE EXPOSED TO FINES OF UP TO \$250.

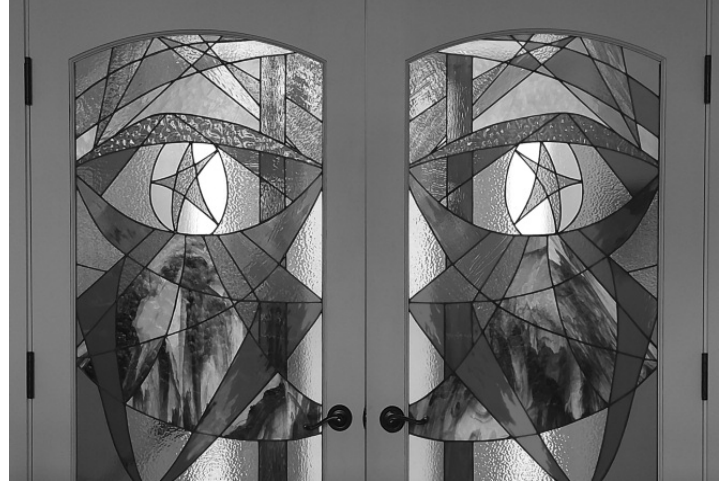
LOCAL ARTISAN OF THE MONTH – OLGA-AMÉLYA FOURNIER

Stained glass artist
Based in Gore for 9 years, I benefit from an exceptional and stimulating setting to create. It's since my early childhood that my interest in colors has manifested itself: first as a child, by modeling and painting characters in clay, then as a teacher with a strong penchant for plastic arts, then in drawing and water-color that I practiced for about ten years.



I fell in love with stained glass while admiring the magnificent stained glass windows exhibited at the Montreal Biosphere in the late 1990s. The color of the glass danced under the effect of the light! Immediately, enchanted by this magic, I wanted to create stained glass! While taking stained glass classes, I became interested in chromotherapy, which is very popular in Europe and which is a set of therapeutic techniques using

the properties of colored lights to maintain and restore health. "The colors emit waves and powerful energies with specific vibrations to each of them and influence the cells of our body". ENVIRONMENT DAY – MAY 22ND 2022

At the Municipal park - 45 Cambria - 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.

On our Environment Day, you can:

- Receive compost (donations to the Sentiers du Gore are greatly appreciated): you must bring your own bag or bucket to carry your compost home.
- Receive a tree for free.
- Drop off your bottles for water analysis with H2Lab - ***Attention*** It is important to fill the H2Lab bottles the same day. (Do not fill them sooner due to a limited window to get bottles back to the lab in time for testing). H2Lab water analysis kits will be available at City Hall from the first week of May. It is important to purchase your test online before picking up your kit. There will soon be information detailing how to purchase and test your water on our website and Facebook page.
- Swap perennials: Bring your cuttings and swap them with other residents.
- Collect seeds - a mixture of native seeds to attract our pollinators will be distributed at the park and can be picked up at the reception of the municipal office.
- Local craftsmen and merchants on site! All artisans and merchants who wish to reserve a place for the Environment Day can do so by filling out the form available on our WEB site, on the "Environment Day" event page or by requesting a copy of the form to the municipality.

REMINDER : MAINTENANCE OF SEPTIC SYSTEMS

Don't forget to empty your septic systems every 2 years for a main residence and every 4 years for a second home. In addition, owners of sealed tanks must empty their systems according to their use, to avoid any overflow or backflow. Septic systems consisting of an advanced secondary system must be bound at all times by a maintenance contract with the company in charge. It is important to send the Municipality all copies of your septic system invoices as well as your annual maintenance contracts. Septic installations are governed by the Provincial Law Q-2.r.22. Any violation of this law is subject to fines up to \$1000 applicable by the Municipality. If your installation is violation of the By-Law, a letter will be sent to you shortly.

FOOD WASTE

The sharp increase in food prices is a source of concern and insecurity for many families. To ensure good management of our purchases and optimal use of food, it is essential to reduce food waste as much as possible. Did you know that 63% of food that is thrown away could have been consumed? In one year, a family can waste an average of 140 kg of food. This could represent a sum of about \$1,100 per year. In Canada, 2.2 million tons of food are wasted each year. Overconsumption inevitably leads to harmful effects on our planet, such as greenhouse gas emissions

from transportation and the use of water resources to water crops. What can we do to avoid wasting food? Here are some tips:

- 1- Plan the meals ahead:** When we have an idea of our meals for the week, it is much easier to proceed to the next step.
- 2- Make a grocery list:** It is always better to go to the grocery store with a shopping list. This way, you will buy only the ingredients you need for your planned meals. Don't hesitate to orient your purchases according to the specials of the week.
- 3- Buy only the ingredients needed for your recipes:** There is no need to buy large quantities of fresh produce. They will end up in the compost more often than in your meals.
- 4- Keep leftovers by freezing them in portions:** Did you make too much again? Freeze leftovers in individual portions. It will be easier to thaw them later.
- 5- Enhance foods that have lost their vitality:** Some vegetables are looking a little tired? Why not use them to make broths, soups or others?
- 6- Share:** Vegetable baskets are a great alternative to expensive groceries. Don't hesitate to share with other families or friends to make it even more affordable.

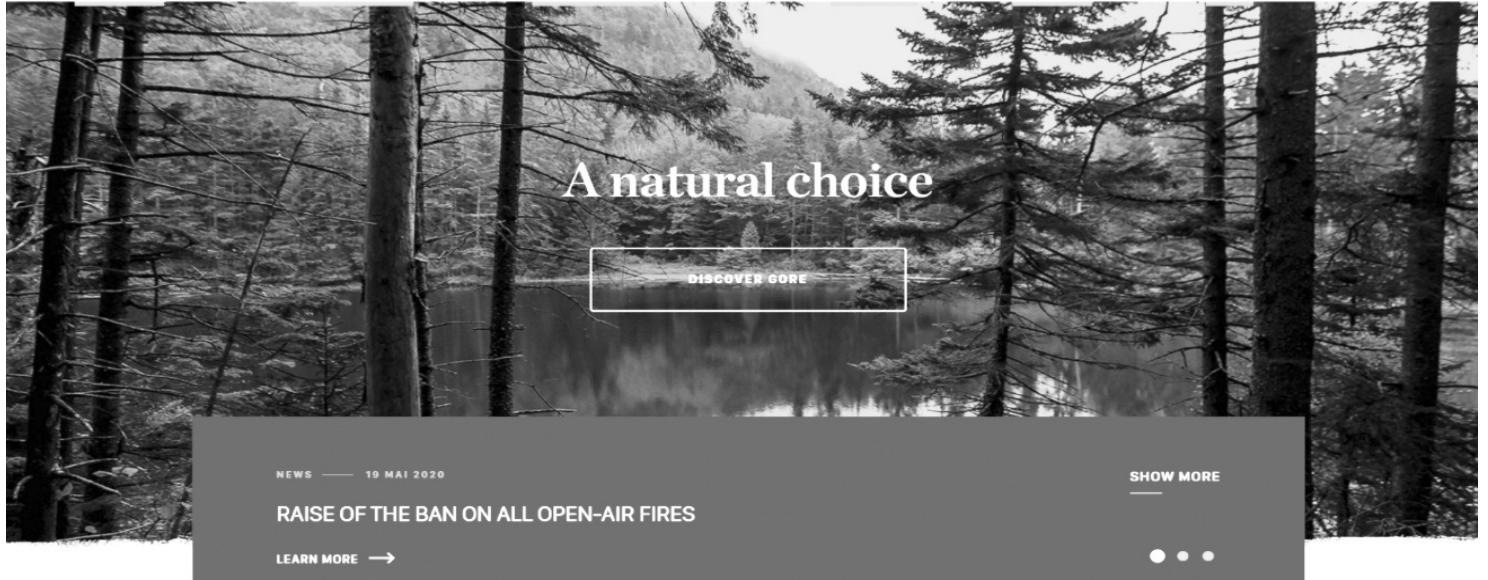

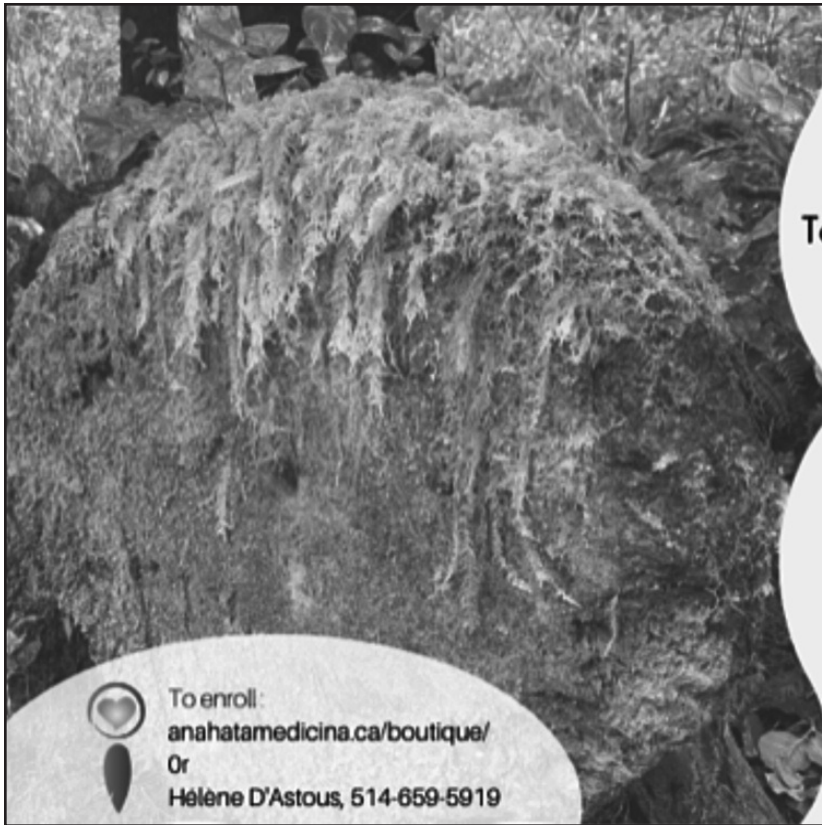
