A WORD FROM THE MAYOR

Dear fellow residents,

It is with great pride that the RCM of Argenteuil learned that, according to the Bulletin sociodémographique de l'institut de la statistique du Québec, it now ranks first among the regional county municipalities (RCMs) in terms of net migration for 2021-2022.

Each year, the Institut de la statistique du Québec draws a portrait of migration in Québec to determine the movements of Québec's population within its territory. This serves as a good indicator of the attractiveness of regions. Positioning is based on the number of individuals entering and leaving, i.e. the amount of new arrivals in the region compared to departures. In 2021-2022, Argenteuil welcomed 2,538 people whereas 1,484 people left, resulting in a net gain of 1,054 residents in our region and representing a net growth rate of 2.99%, by far the highest in Quebec.

The RCM of Argenteuil, with the financial support of the Government of Quebec, launched the "INHALE. BREATHE. ARGENTEUIL" campaign in 2021, whose objective is to promote the territory and attract new faces, either to live, work or develop. In addition, the campaign is intended to strengthen the sense of belonging that Argenteuillois(es) have for their region. The campaign highlights local entrepreneurs, immigrant families who have chosen Argenteuil, jobs offered within territory, tourist attractions and many other aspects that make each of the nine local municipalities a prime place to settle. For many years, the RCM of Argenteuil has joined forces with community partners to attract new residents and workers, particularly at national events addressing employment and immigration themes.

In my capacity as RCM's Warden, I have once said:

"The RCM of Argenteuil is the ideal place for young families, entrepreneurs and immigrants who are looking for peace of mind to settle. It is with great pride that we learned that our RCM ranked first in migration rates in 2021-2022. Beyond statistics, Argenteuil is a community where people can flourish, accomplish their goals and adopt a lifestyle that allows them to pace themselves, to have access to nature as well as services"

A REGION LOOKING TOWARDS THE FUTURE

The RCM of Argenteuil stives for smart and sustainable development while offering a quality of life that is both balanced and advanced in nature. Indeed, the region's wealth is largely based on its close-knit community, diversified local businesses, innovative industries, astute farmers and the natural environments that cover more than half the territory. It is fair to say that Argenteuil is currently the region in Quebec where life is good!

Council authorizes an operating budget of \$6,047,143 and appropriates \$279,000 from the unallocated surplus to balance the operating budget. Also, the council authorizes the allocation of an amount of \$90,000 from the growth fund.

The general property tax rate for 2023 is set at \$0.41 per \$100 of assessment. A tax of \$0.066 of the \$100 evaluation will be charged to cover the costs of the MRC d'Argenteuil. The tax for public safety is set at \$0.164 per \$100 of assessment. Therefore, the total tax rate for the year 2023 will be \$0.64 per \$100 of assessment.

The tax for household waste and recycling will be \$265 per residence. The special environmental protection tax will be \$60 per assessment unit.

The council monthly salaries for 2023 will be as follows:

The remuneration of municipal employees for 2023 will be increased by 6.7% according to the consumer price index published by Statistics Canada and the salary step adjustment will be applied according to the agreements in force. The remuneration of firefighters will be increased according to the rates negotiated in the agreement in force.

On the municipality's website, you will also find the three-year capital plan 2023-2025 adopted by the council.



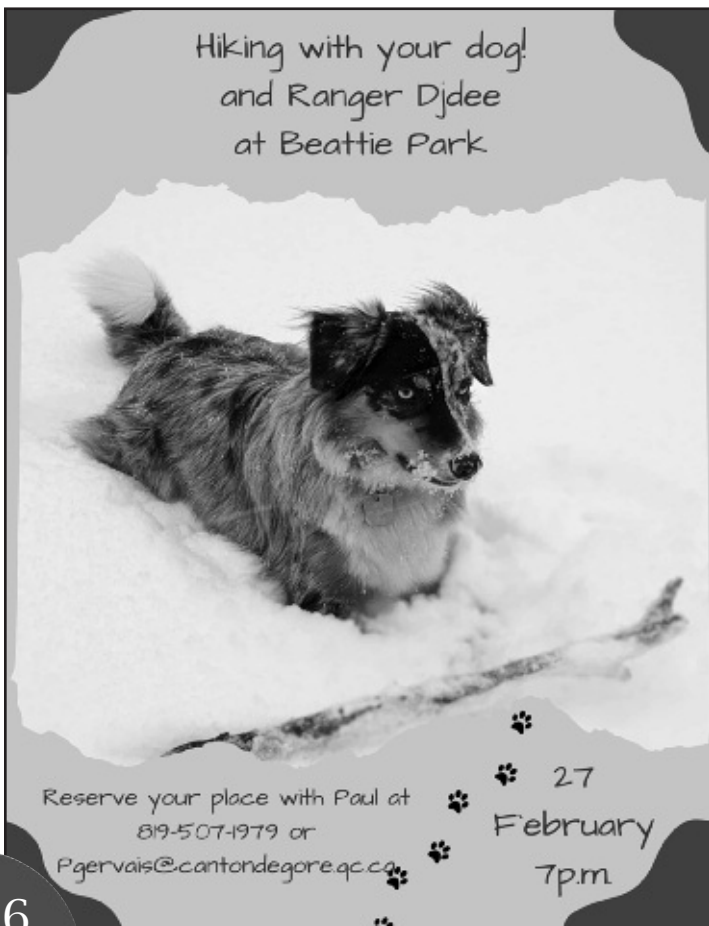
