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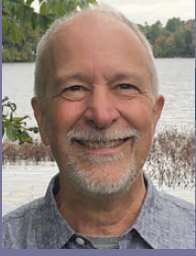

The Council authorizes an operating budget of \$ 6 647 153. It also authorizes an allocation of \$ 42 152 to the accumulated surplus for the *Programme d'aide à la relance de l'industrie touristique (PARIT)* and Breault Park as well as an allocation of \$ 32 150 from the park fund. The authorized capital budget is \$ 1 302 750.

The general property tax rate for the year 2025 is set at \$ 0.4387 per \$ 100 assessment. A fee of \$ 0.0658 per \$100 of assessment is charged to cover expenses for RCM of Argenteuil services. The tax for public safety and fire protection services is set at \$ 0.160 per \$100 of assessment. Therefore, the total tax rate for the year 2025 is \$ 0.6645 per \$100 of assessment.

The tax for household garbage and recycling will be \$ 233 per residence. The special environmental protection charge will be \$ 52 per unit of assessment.

## 2024 FOOD DRIVE REVIEW

This year, an army of volunteers got involved in the Food Drive and the people of Gore showed their great generosity towards their fellow citizens in need. The door-to-door campaign allowed us to collect a large quantity of food and 31 Gore families received well-stocked Christmas baskets. Here is the summary of the money collected during our food drive:

To this amount, we must add the contribution of the Trésors du Dôme of \$3,600 in supermarket gift cards. Les Trésors du Dôme, an organization that serves the municipalities of Gore, Wentworth and Mille-Isles, provided 72 \$50 gift cards distributed in the Christmas baskets of the three municipalities.

The purchase of food cost \$3,431.26. We are therefore ending the year with a surplus that can be used for future years. We would like to warmly thank all our donors and especially all the volunteers involved in organizing the food drive.

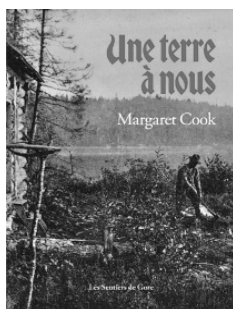

## THE ECO-LOAN PROGRAM

In 2023, the Municipality reintroduces the Eco-Loan program to help residents with the replacement of their non-compliant or aging septic systems. The program applies to all homeowners of the Municipality. With this program, it is possible to obtain financial assistance in the form of a reimbursable loan for all costs related to the process of changing a septic installation. Financial assistance is calculated according to the value of the property (excluding land) and household income. # RECYCLING REFORM 2025



As of January 1, 2025, a major reform of selective recycling has been implemented in Quebec. The project led by Éco Entreprises Québec (ÉEQ) will make the collection process much simpler and more uniform for all citizens. What's new? We no longer need to check whether our packaging is marked "recycled" or whether the number on it is actually accepted in the bin. If the item fits into one of the three categories, it will be recyclable. There are a few exceptions: aerosols and expanded polystyrene packaging (which degrades into small beads). However, polystyrene meat trays are accepted.

## Good practices

- Continue to separate materials (e.g. cookie box and plastic tray).
- Separate container lids and caps if larger than 5 cm.
- Empty and lightly rinse materials.
- Compact aluminium foil in balls.
- Do not nest materials together.
- Be careful with hazardous materials and heavily soiled products.
