TAX BILLS

You will receive your tax account for 2020 in the coming days. We sent it by post on Tuesday February 25. As you can see, the account is due on March 26, 2020. If your tax account is higher than \$ 300, you can pay in 4 installments.

The dates of these payments are:

- March 26, 2020 • May 4, 2020 • July 6, 2020 • October 5, 2020

If you do not respect the schedule and the amounts of the 4 payments, you will lose the privilege of paying in 4 installments and the total amount of the account will be due in 1 installment.

The municipal office has sent more than 3000 accounts accompanied by the 2020 municipal budget. If you have not yet received your account, please contact us and we will be happy to remedy the situation.

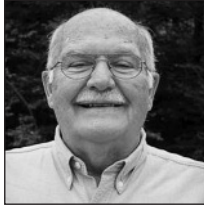

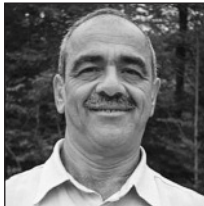

Lake Beattie Project

I would like to update you on the Lake Beattie Park project. The municipal employees worked hard to set up the project and especially to seek grants in order to reduce the tax burden of the residents to make this wonderful nature park project of nearly 270 hectares a reality. Applications have been made under two major provincial government subsidy programs, the Support Program for Upgrading and Improving Trails and Outdoor Activities (PSSPA) and the

Recreational and Sports Infrastructure Financial Assistance Program (PAFIRS). We hope to get positive responses quickly and share the good news with you.

We have received the support of many partners, who support the project and help us in our dealings with the government. Les Sentiers de Gore and Conservation Lakefield have provided us with very important letters of support. We thank them warmly for their support. In addition, the MRC and the city of Lachute, as well as the Tourisme Laurentides organization, have given us their support through resolutions and an official letters of support.

This project is extremely promising for our municipality and for our MRC. We are moving towards its realization.

COMPOSTING

For over a year now, community compost bins have been installed in various locations in the municipality. They are very popular and we are very happy with them. For their location, you can consult the Municipal website.

However, some non-organic materials have been found in the bins recently. **It is very important not to contaminate the compost bins with non-compostable materials.**

Here is a list of materials not to put in the bin: stones, dead animals, clay, corks, candle wax, cotton swabs, baby diapers, softener sheets, gum, cleansing wipes, disposable wipes and Swiffer type sheets, liquids (soup, soup, juice), cigarette butts and ashes, dryer foam, dressings, plastic wrap, invasive plants, plastic (oxo-biodegradable, compostable), dust and vacuum bags, sanitary towels, disposable underwear, Styrofoam, cleansing pads, sanitary pads, textiles, earth and carpets.

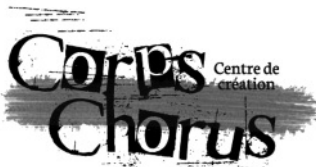

TANDOORI TURKEY LEGS

INGREDIENTS

- 2 turkey legs, about 1 1/2 lbs (675 g) each, with the skin
- 1 cup (250 ml) 10% plain yogurt
- 2 cloves garlic, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons (30 ml) fresh ginger, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons (30 ml) chopped fresh cilantro
- 2 tablespoons (30 ml) lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons (30 ml) olive oil
- 2 teaspoons (10 ml) ground cumin
- 2 teaspoons (10 ml) ground coriander
- 2 teaspoons (10 ml) garam masala
- 2 teaspoons (10 ml) paprika
- 1 teaspoon (5 ml) salt
- 1 lemon, cut into wedges
- Pepper

PREPARATION

With a knife, make four or five long and deep incisions in the turkey legs. Set aside.

In a glass dish, combine the remaining ingredients, except for the lemon wedges. Add the turkey legs and coat well with the marinade. Cover with plastic wrap. Refrigerate for 12 to 24 hours.

With the rack in the middle position, preheat the oven to 180 °C (350 °F).

Remove the legs from the marinade without wiping off too much, and place in a baking dish. Discard the remaining marinade. Season with pepper. Cover with a sheet of aluminum foil and bake for about 2 hours or until the meat falls easily from the bone.

Remove the foil and cook under the broiler for about 5 minutes or until the legs are golden brown. Adjust the seasoning. Serve the turkey legs in a platter with the lemon wedges. You can also halve each turkey leg and serve them separately.



NOTE

If desired, strain the cooking juices through a sieve to serve with the turkey pieces.
